- 2. Reviewed feedback regarding Academic Calendar:
 - a. Overwhelming preference for "Option A," however some shared concerns that neither option offered Labor Day.
 - b. Reflection on shifting priorities taking place in Dean of Students' office
 - c. Discussion of the nature of Pre-Semester Advising (for first-year students and seniors), and possible alternatives for our current practices. The committee determined that these practices align more closely with the purview of ASAA.
 - d. The Committee chose to solicit feedback from non-faculty members of ASAA and Student Life. The Chair will reach out to them.
- 3. Discussion of Failed Faculty Search Policy:
 - a. Review of Advisory Committee's proposed policy, with edits made to align it more closely with current faculty position review procedures (which includes a role for EPC). This proposed policy would require search committee chairs to submit a report to be reviewed by the Provost, Advisory Committee, and EPC.
 - b. In recognition of changes to Faculty Search Procedures currently underway, EPC will wait until new procedures are in place so that this Failed Search policy may be aligned within that framework.
- 4. Brief Discussion of Homework for upcoming Assessment Work:
 - a. Read Chair's "Assessment Summary," posted on Moodle
 - b. Review current Assessment Guidelines on Globe; consider effectiveness, etc (Chair will provide a draft of updates via email).
