Discussion on the required Transfer Credits at Wells

- Currently Wells requires 60 credits to be taken at our institution; others can be a low as 30 credits.
- Also, the required Wells courses needed within the major (6) and minor (4) is restricting our efforts to bring Transfer Students to Wells.
- Questioned: How will a reduction effect thesis expectations and internship connections at Wells.
- To make this change in the Faculty Manual:
 - o Will need to be a Notice of Motion with the Faculty
 - o Meet with Curriculum Committee at the start of the spring semester
 - Professor Burwell will draft up a few samples of that a change may look like in the Faculty Manual to bring to CC and the faculty.
