1. Minutes

2. Academic Calendar Discussion

The Committee discussed the staff feedback it received to the draft fall calendar it circulated. It also discussed the placement of fall break and the timing of mid-semester grades. Having made corrections to some errors, members of the Committee agreed that the revised proposed calendar should be taken to the next Faculty Meeting for approval. 3. Assessment Discussion

The Committee discussed briefly the Chair's Summary Document that had been shared. In thinking about the Committee's role in guiding the assessment process, how can the Committee provide the best support and feedback to faculty? We know there is a need for a certain amount of consistency while at the same time a need for flexibility.

Homework for next week is to spend more time reviewing the Summary Document and be prepared to discuss priorities for assessment reports and how to provide feedback. The Chair indicated that she would work on the Assessment Globe page.
