**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Students apply to the certification program in the spring of their **sophomore** year.
- Students apply to student teach in the spring of their **junior** year.
- 2 semesters of a language ( 6 credit hours)
- NYS requires fingerprinting (The fee as of July 1, 2020 is \$102.00)
