Adolescence Education Minor

Grades 7-12

Students who are interested in education but either do not wish to or do not have time to complete the certification program may minor in education. Students completing the minor alone will have a strong foundation in education but will NOT be eligible for certification. They may, however, use this course work as a basis for graduate school in MAT programs. See the director of elementary and secondary education for further information. All students, including those in the certification program, must declare their education minor no later than the last day of classes of their junior year.

The total number of courses required for the minor is 7 (22 semester hours). NOTE: Completing the minor alone does not qualify a student for initial certification.
