

**Dean of Students Office Judicial Affairs & Student Conduct Code:
Summary Report Fall 2011
January 31, 2012**

Staff within the Dean of Students Office met with 70 students who were charged with violating the Student Conduct Code, Residence Life Polices and/or Community Standards during the Fall 2011 semester.

*Note: The numbers below indicate the number of individuals found RESPONSIBLE for violating the Student Conduct Code/Residence Life Policies/Community Standards, not the number of incidents that occurred. (Example: if an incident is documented where 10 individuals were charged and found RESPONSIBLE for a violation, the number reported is “10,” not “1”).
