

**Dean of Students Office Judicial Affairs & Student Conduct Code:
Summary Report Spring 2012
June 30, 2012**

Staff within the Dean of Students Office met with 69 students who were charged with violating the Student Conduct Code, Residence Life Policies and/or Community Standards during the Spring 2012 semester.

*Note: The numbers below indicate the number of individuals found RESPONSIBLE for violating the Student Conduct Code/Residence Life Policies/Community Standards, not the number of incidents that occurred. (Example: if an incident is documented where 10 individuals were charged and found RESPONSIBLE for a violation, the number reported is “10,” not “1”).
