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Step 7: First year students need to add one section of WLLS 100 and a gateway course (see list). You must also register for WLLS 105 in either the Fall or Spring semester of your first year at Wells. You may be placed into WLLS 105 based on the writing placement test given during orientation. Students should add 3-4 other courses within their intended major, general education courses, or elective courses. All students must take 12 credits to be considered full-time and should *average* 15 credits each semester.
